Our Lodging Accommodations



We will be staying at the Forest Suites Resort located in the Heavenly Village area of South Lake Tahoe, CA. The resort offers 2-bedroom / 2-bathroom suites. These suites provide a common sitting and entertainment area as well as a cooking and dining area for those looking to cook at home. A gourmet continental breakfast is provided each day in the resorts dining room and is included in the package price.

The Forest Suite Resorts provide many amenities such as outside hot tubs, outside heated pools, fitness center and onsite Beer and Wine Lounge. There is an onsite ski rental shop. The resort is located just 100 feet from the Heavenly Gondola and is just minutes away from "Casino Corridor" in Nevada for your nightly dining and entertainment. South Lake Tahoe, CA offers a huge variety of dining and shopping for those looking for a quieter more relaxing evening. You couldn't ask for a better location.

Travel Arraignments

Our carrier will be United Airlines flying from Boston Logan Airport to Reno Airport with one stop in Denver to change planes. There will be a 45 minute bus ride from Reno to South Lake Tahoe as well as the bus from Fitchburg to Boston. We will be skiing at four resorts; 3-days at Heavenly, 1-day each at Kirkwood, Alpine Meadows and Squaw Valley. Here are the statistics of each mountain:

Total Trails: 94 – 20% green, 45% blue, 35% b

Vertical Drop: 3500 feet

Lifts: 18 chairs, 1 Gondola, 1 Tram



Skiable Terrain: 4000 acres, **Longest Run:** 3.5 miles
Total Trails: 170 – 25% green, 45% blue, 30% black
Vertical Drop: 2900 feet
Lifts: 25 chairs, 2 Gondolas, 1 Tram



Skiable Terrain: 2300 acres, **Longest Run:** 2.5 miles
Total Trails: 65 – 15% green, 50% blue, 35% balck
Vertical Drop: 220 feet
Lifts: 10 chairs



Skiable Terrain: 2400 acres, **Longest Run:** 2.5 miles
Total Trails: 91 – 25% green, 40% blue, 35% black
Vertical Drop: 2000 feet
Lifts: 12 chairs

The Package

The package is based on quad occupancy. Suites configurations are 2-bedrooms/2-bath with a selection of both bedrooms with king beds or 1-bedroom king and the other bedroom has 2 beds.
